	 6. Post Installation Inspection: All projects requesting an incentive of \$2,500 or greater are subject to a site inspection. MMWEC GO Program will contact the participant to set up a convenient time for the site inspection. Other projects will be randomly assigned a site inspection at the discretion of MMWEC GO Program. 7. Incentive Payment: An incentive check will be issued for all projects that successfully meet the parameters of the program. See below for more information about financial incentives.

Target End Uses	Target end uses include all HVAC retrofit projects that result in energy savings. Eligible HVAC projects must be ENERGY STAR® qualified. Check energystar.gov for the most current listing of eligible equipment.
Financial Incentives*	 The exact product types listed on the application form are eligible for prescriptive incentives. (See our HVAC Guide for more information.) Each business is eligible for MMWEC GO Program incentives up to \$25,000 per business, per calendar year. MMWEC GO Program the right to monitor and/or inspect the installation and energy use of the products for which incentives are paid.
