Q1. In going through the bid, I noticed that a lot of the material is schedule 80 and for some of the material, schedule 80 is not possible. Was this just put on every piece of material and does it all have to be schedule 80?

A1. Please bid schedule 80 on conduit.

Q2. Do you accept crosses or does it need to be the exact manufacturer and part # requested?

A2. We accept crosses but you must add a notation of the manufacturer and the part number in the description area. Please bold or highlight it.

Q1. Would they put in a 12-month order with multiple ship dates or possibly quarterly orders? Curious what the overall opportunity size is to guarantee 12-month pricing. In this case with Clearfield, are they only going to purchase 5000 of each over the whole year?

A2. We place orders as needed for parts that are low on stock throughout the year. There is no guarantee of the number we will order or how often. The quantity listed on the bid lists are the usual amount we would order at a given time, but we may not order any of a particular part in 2026.

Q1. Speaking of Clearfield, they told me they do not make a 16/14 microduct, that the closest size is 14/10. Referring to stock# 2516 & 2517. Is there any clarification?
