



Enel X JuiceBox EV Chargers Now Enrolling in Connected Homes!

South Hadley Electric Light Department (SHELD) customers who own Enel X JuiceBox electric vehicle (EV) chargers are now eligible to enroll the chargers into the HELPS Connected Homes smart device program.



Drive Electric

By enrolling an EV charger into the Connected Homes Program, customers agree to allow Connected Homes to make brief, limited adjustments to their device during times of peak electric demand.



Get Notified

During times of peak electric demand, SHELD customers will be notified of a possible adjustment that will change the charging rate of their Enel X JuiceBox charger for a limited time.



Get Rewarded

Customers will be notified of the change via email and given the option to opt out. Customers who participate will earn a \$10 monthly incentive that is paid out quarterly via incentive checks.
